

FOR ALL DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENTS:

Some of you may qualify for an ACE scholarship that can be used to pay for your dual enrollment course. ACE stands for Access College Early and is a Nebraska-based initiative. If your family meets one of the following criteria then you can apply.

- Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program
- Supplemental Security Income
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Special Supplemental Assistance Program (WIC)

You may also be eligible if your family has encountered a significant financial hardship. If you are eligible based on the above list, please create an account at the ACE [website](#).

Once you have an account, you can login and and start your registration.

Important information:

You must have a Social Security Number to apply.

Be sure to list your name the same way you listed it on the dual enrollment paperwork.

Find out if your course is considered a fall term or a spring term course by the college.

Have current-year documentation to demonstrate your eligibility. It will need to be in JPEG or PDF format to upload to the website.

You can receive scholarships for up to 6 dual enrollment courses during the 2022-2023 school year.
